Morning Classes and Activities Standing In The Gap!

LESSON TEXT: Ezekiel 22:23-31

LESSON PRAYER: Lord, give me courage to stand for righteousness even when I must stand alone.

INTRODUCTION AND THEME EXPOSITION

God speaks to Ezekiel in our lesson. He acknowledges the sins of the priests and prophets in Israel. God dispenses judgment because he was unable to find one person to stand in the gap. In those days, a gap was considered to be a breach in a wall of defense. During battles, when the gaps were made, the leaders were responsible for defending the group by filling in the gaps; thereby preventing the enemy from entering and taking over. Not one prophet or priest would tell the children of Israel of their wrongdoing. Sin stepped in and took over. God became angry.

Today, God is still looking for someone to stand in the gap. He wants someone who is not afraid to stand up for righteousness. He is not just looking for ministers. He is looking for you. Are you willing to stand in the gap for Christ? Are you willing to tell your friends and loved ones of their wrong doings?

There are many people who will become angry when told about faults and sins. Some will be grateful and will repent and turn to God. Others will hate you for truth's sake. You can not fear man. Did Jesus? Did Peter? Moses? All of these, and others stood in the gap!

The youth of today must stand in the gap against drugs, homosexuality, premarital sex, dishonesty, and all other manner of immorality and sin. STAND IN THE GAP at home, at school, and at church.



PRACTICAL EMPHASIS

- 1. It takes courage to speak up for right in the midst of wrong.
- 2. Fear God rather than man.
- 3. It is better to become aware of your faults now so that they can be corrected. Judgment day is too late.

MIRROR REFLECTIONS AND THOUGHTS

- 4. God sought for a man to stand in the gap and found none. Why?
- 5. What characteristics are necessary to stand in the gap?
- 6. Disobedience is a gap.
- 7. Are you willing to stand in the gap?
- 8. A chain is as strong as its weakest link.

INTERACTIONS

1. Demonstrate the child's game "Red Rover" and explain how it relates to the lesson. Role play an example of how a gap occurs and its results. Discuss the provisions made for handling a gap as outlined in the

Decree pg. 45, "Decree on Obedience," paragraphs 3-6.
